GARY FARMER Hosts Santa Fe Independent Film Festival Awards Ceremony at the Lensic Performing Arts Center Followed by the NM Premiere of the SXSW hit FUNERAL KINGS

Santa Fe, NM (September 24, 2012) Santa Fe Independent Film Festival is three weeks away. Beginning on Wednesday, October 17th through Sunday, October 21st. Santa Fe IFF is looking forward to presenting its most exciting festival to date. On Saturday evening, GARY FARMER (DEAD MAN, POW WOW HIGHWAY, THE SCORE) hosts Santa Fe IFF's Non-Juried Awards Ceremony at The Lensic Performing Arts Center beginning at 7 p.m. Director Matthew McManus and producer Michael McGary will be in attendance to introduce the New Mexican premiere of their SxSW hit FUNERAL KINGS, and for a Q&A after the screening. "FUNERAL KINGS has nabbed comparisons to both "Stand By Me" and "Superbad." Following a group of foul-mouthed, angel-faced, middle school altar boys who stumble upon some dangerous gangsta dealings led by the local video store owner (a perfectly cast Kevin Corrigan), the McManus brothers' astonishingly assured debut also plays like Tarantino channeled through the mouths of babes." Kevin Corrigan is also featured in the Santa Fe IFF's Official Selection SUPPORTING CHARACTERS, which will be screened at Warehouse 21 on Thursday October 18th at 7 pm. The runway Tribeca Film Festival hit stars Alex Karpovsky (*GIRLS*, *SLEEPWALK WITH ME*, *TINY FURNITURE*) and features a hilarious cameo from his co star and creator of *GIRLS* Lena Dunham.

Santa Fe IFF Non-Juried Awards are hosted by GARY FARMER Co-Chair of Santa Fe IFF's Advisory Board. Gary will present the 2012 awards to filmmaker CHRIS EYRE (*HIDEAWAY*, *SKINS*, *CSNY*) . Other esteemed awardees include Jon Hendry who will receive Santa Fe IFF's Cornerstone Award for his contribution for the film industry in New Mexico. Awards are designed by Fred Lopez of Santa Fe Tinworks. Santa Fe IFF' first annual Tamalewood award will be presented to Tatanka Means for his work in New Mexico. Other awardees will be announced soon.
